

Memorandum of Understanding on the Social Implementation of Hydrogen Energy between the Tokyo Metropolitan Government and the State of New South Wales

The Tokyo Metropolitan Government and the State of New South Wales have confirmed that both states will further strengthen the cooperative relationship they have built to date, collaborate in the following areas as trailblazers of energy transition, accelerate the social implementation of hydrogen energy by combining their wisdom and experience, and take the lead in the international community from both environmental and economic perspectives.

Both states have also shared their intention to have practical exchanges to further develop the friendly and cooperative relationship between them.

- (1) Creation of an international supply chain
- (2) Technology development
- (3) Increase in demand
- (4) Other matters both states deem necessary for the social implementation of hydrogen.

Both states have decided to ensure the promotion of exchange and cooperation in the areas agreed upon by them by appointing the Bureau of Industrial and Labor Affairs, Tokyo Metropolitan Government and the Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water, New South Wales Government as the responsible organisations.

This Memorandum has been made in duplicate in English and Japanese, both equally authentic. Both cities shall hold one copy of each text.

This Memorandum is signed in the State of New South Wales on February , 2024 and will be effective from the date signed by both states.
